Who can take part

This clinical trial may be an option for people who:

- Are 5 years of age or older
- Are in generally good health or have stable chronic medical conditions
- Have not tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 3 months
- Have not received a COVID-19 vaccine within the last 3 months
- Have not had a serious reaction to a vaccine in the past

The study includes people from a variety of age groups and health backgrounds. The study team will review your health history to see if you [or your child] qualify.

There are other requirements that the study team will discuss with you.



What to expect



If this clinical trial is a good fit for you and you agree to take part, you will receive a single dose of a study vaccine. The trial includes different groups of participants, and the way vaccines are assigned may vary depending on the group you join. This study does not include a placebo (an injection with no active ingredients).



You should not receive another COVID-19 vaccine, whether approved or still being studied.



Participation lasts for about [6 months] and includes [at least 3] visits with the study team. You may have an additional visit if you develop symptoms or test positive for COVID-19.



[There is no cost to participate.] [You may also be paid for completing study visits and other study-related activities.]

Your safety and your choice

- Before joining the study, you will be given all the details about participation, including potential benefits and risks, so you can decide if this study is right for you.
- Safety is the most important part of this clinical trial. The study team will carefully monitor your health, including any side effects, throughout the clinical trial.
- You can contact the study team at any time if you have questions or concerns about your health.

You are always in control. You can leave the study at any time, for any reason.
